

MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING
JUNE 9, 2014

The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners held their regular meeting on Monday, June 9, 2014 at 5:30 pm. Members present were Frank Brantley, John Carpenter, Vernon Sumner, and Tim Williamson.

Chairman Sumner called the meeting to order.

Following the pledge to the flag, Commissioner Brantley led the invocation.

The agenda was amended to remove Chamber Report, EMA Report, and add DFACS Board appointment to new business on a motion by Commissioner Carpenter, seconded by Commissioner Williamson. Motion carried.

The regular minutes were amended and approved and the Executive Session minutes were approved on a motion by Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Carpenter. Motion carried.

Joe Filippone of the Development Authority reported that they took ownership of the Hardeman building last week and he has a prospect for the property on 280. The City of Mt Vernon will have a Hog Wild festival September 26, & 27. There will be a Bar-B-Q cook off, a car and motorcycle show, parade, arts & crafts, softball tournament and possibly a fair.

A representative from Jobs Unlimited appeared before the Board to explain some of the services of this organization.

Robert "Red" Wheeler appeared before the Board with concerns about his drive. Mr. Wheeler said the grader covered up the rocks in his drives with dirt. Mr. Wheeler would like the Commissioners to let people know what the road department is doing.

The Board reviewed the road department reports. On a motion by Commissioner Brantley, seconded by Commissioner Carpenter the Board declared two bush hogs and the Savannah plow surplus equipment to be sold. Motion carried. Manager Braddy told the Board that every complaint was documented by a work order and spreadsheet and he appreciates the road crew.

The Board reviewed the financial reports.

The Board reviewed a letter from the City of Ailey stating they were financially unable to contribute to the Recreation budget at this time.

On a motion by Commissioner Brantley, seconded by Commissioner Williamson the Board agreed to sign the 2014 – 2015 Inmate Detail contract. Motion carried.

On a motion by Commissioner Brantley, seconded by Commissioner Williamson the Board reappointed Rev. F. Lee Carter to the Department of Family & Children Service Board for a five year term. Motion carried.

On a motion by Commissioner Carpenter, seconded by Commissioner Williamson the Board went into Executive Session to discuss personnel and pending legal issues. Motion carried.

On a motion by Commissioner Carpenter, seconded by Commissioner Williamson the Board came out of Executive Session. Motion carried.

On a motion by Commissioner Brantley, seconded by Commissioner Williamson the Board agreed to increase Jonathan Adams' salary by .50 per hour effective May 29, 2014. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Commissioner Carpenter, seconded by Commissioner Brantley. Motion carried.
