

MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 13, 2014

The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners held their regular meeting on Monday, October 13, 2014 at 5:30 pm. Members present were Frank Brantley, John Carpenter, Vernon Sumner, Clarence Thomas and Tim Williamson.

Chairman Sumner called the meeting to order. Following the pledge to the flag, the invocation was led by Commissioner Thomas.

The agenda was approved on a motion by Commissioner Carpenter, seconded by Commissioner Williamson. Motion carried.

The minutes were approved on a motion by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Brantley. Motion carried.

Bill Mitchell from the Chamber of Commerce gave an update on the Chamber's activities.

Under Reports, Manager Braddy told the Board he was working on an operations policy and he and John Roller were working on a right of way ordinance. John Oglesby from Alston has a large amount of dirt he has offered to the County and he would also like his drive fixed. The County Manager and Road Superintendent will work with Mr. Oglesby on this.

Manager Braddy has been working on implementing the Phase II Wireless for E-911 which will allow wireless calls to be sent to the County's E-911 center instead of Toombs County.

Under New Business, the Board appointed EMA Director Andy Leanza to the Region 5 EMS Advisory Council on a motion by Commissioner Williamson, seconded by Commissioner Brantley. Motion carried.

The 2012 taxes for the Three Rivers Bait & Tackle property that was donated to the County by Belinda Hamilton have not been paid. The Board may have to pay the school part of these taxes but will check with the school board to see if they will waive these taxes.

Under Comments, Commissioner Thomas said he would like the Road Department to return to a five day work schedule when the time changes back in November.

Mickey Fountain wants a flag pole placed at the Kibbee Fire Sub Station and the station be named the C.D. Fountain Station because their family donated the property for the station. Mickey Fountain will purchase the pole and flag. He would also like a walkway to the flagpole. The Board agreed to have this flagpole placed at the station and to name it the C.D. Fountain Fires Station.

Manager Braddy told the Board the surplus equipment had been sold.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned on a motion by Commissioner Thomas, seconded by Commissioner Williamson. Motion carried.
